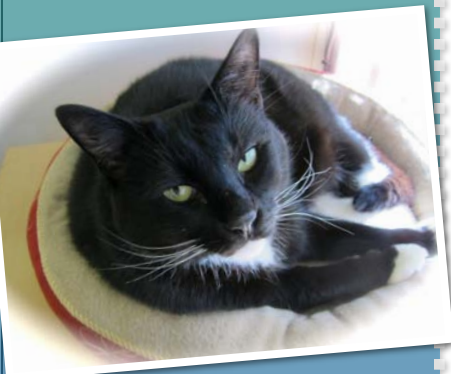




❖ Dr. Melanie Ellis ❖

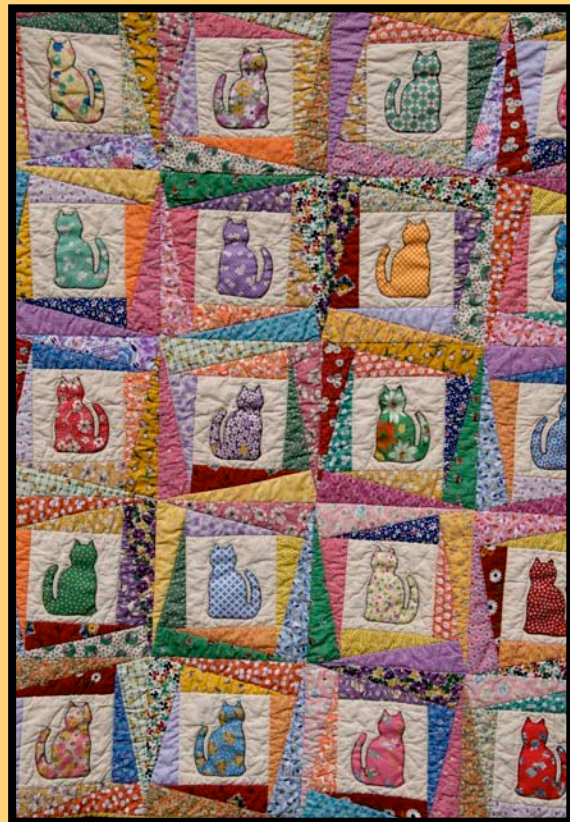
Stray Cats of Momenvasia, Greece. Dr. T wanted to bring them home!
